POST YOUR OWN SCORE FOR HANDICAPS

The Kansas Golf Association and the Kansas Women's Golf Association has set the 2010 handicap season from March 1 through October 31. The first revision will be available on March 19th. Please turn in all scores during this time period, following USGA Golf rules.

Enter your own scores into the computer located in the Golf Shop. We recommend that each group send one person to enter scores for the whole group. Instructions and assistance is available by any of the Golf Shop staff.

Those needing to establish a new handicap at the club should sign-up in the Golf Shop. The annual charge for handicap is \$20.00 per year. Those members already on the system will be billed for 2010 on the March statement. The Crestwood Women's Golf Association members handicap charges are included in their annual dues and won't be charged again.

Official handicaps are required for some Crestwood tournaments and other area events.

Junior Golf: Tuesday mornings June 8 to July 27. Junior play days for age 9 and up have a weekly clinic and organized play in 3,5 and 9 hole groups, starting @ 8:00 am. Pee Wee golf is for ages 5 to 8 and meets from 11:00 to Noon. Light instruction and play will be organized by our staff. Parent-Junior fun night will be on Tuesday, August 4th at 6:00 pm and will include golf cook-out and swimming. (Grandchildren of members may participate. Children of Social members are also eligible. A nominal fee applies in each case.) Junior golfers have priority until 10:30 a.m.

Couples League: Tuesday evenings beginning May 11. Shotgun start at @ 6:00 pm for 9 holes using the entire course. The format is simple, fun and easy even for inexperienced players. Golf is followed by an optional dinner and social. Info will be mailed.

Men's Day: Wednesday is Men Only on #1 tee from 1:00 to 5:00 pm, April through October.

Men's Golf Assoc: A \$20 fee for annual handicap and administration.

- Stag Nights twice per month on Wednesday, scheduled scramble events and Men's Club Championship

Crestwood Women's Golf Association has both a morning and evening league beginning April 1. Morning plays 18 holes from 8:30 to Noon. The evening 9 hole league begins at 6:00 pm. Their fees of \$45 include GHIN handicap, KWGA dues and club championship entry. They also have a Member-Guest Tournament and Coal Bucket Invitational.

Ladies Golf Clinic: Golf clinics are available on Wednesday evenings beginning in April for six weeks.

TEE TIME POLICY: Weekend and Holiday tee times will be accepted one week in advance.

GOLF RULES REVIEWED

- All players must register in the Golf Shop
 - Guests must be registered with name and address on our golf register
 - Members are responsible for paying or signing for their own golf cart fees. If not, staff will bill accordingly.
 - All groups are requested to play in under four hours.
 - Five balls in play per group maximum unless otherwise specified by the Golf Committee. A group of six allowed November till March if round is under 4 hours.
 - Groups smaller than four may be paired into full groups at the Pro's discretion.
 - Member owned golf carts shall not be driven around the property by drivers under age 16 unless accompanied by an adult. Rental cart drivers must be 16 years of age.
 - Double up on carts whenever possible — save cart damage on the golf course
 - The 90 degree rule is always in effect unless CARTS ON PATH ONLY signs are posted.
 - Play the golf course in the proper sequence 1,2,3,4. . . . You may begin on #10 at the Pro's permission.
 - Please limit your time in Legends at the turn to 5 minutes or less. You must keep your position on #10 tee or you may be required to restart on #1.
 - Junior golfers (Age 11 and under) must be accompanied by an adult (18 or over) on weekends. The golf shop staff has the right to restrict junior play during busy times that the junior may not be able to handle.
 - Tee times are available for weekends and holidays and take priority. They may be booked by calling the Golf Shop one week in advance.
 - All food and beverage consumed at Crestwood must be purchased from the club.
- DRESS CODE:** No un-hemmed shorts. Collared shirts please. You must wear either flat-soled tennis shoes or alternative spiked golf shoes. No traditional golf spikes allowed
- MONDAY :** Course Closed Until Noon
TUESDAY: Prior to 11:00 Junior Golf (June to July) Couples League 6:00 shotgun (May to July)
WEDNESDAY: Men Only on #1 tee from 1:00 to 5:00 pm (April to October)
THURSDAY: CWGA Women only until Noon (April to October).
