Men's Four-Ball Match Play Scheduled

Opening day for Men's Four-Ball Match Play will be on Saturday, September 11.

Teams consisting of two-man teams playing best ball against another team in your flight. Flights will be pre-determined by combined total handicap. Handicaps will be used in the match using the following method:

- The course handicap of all four players is reduced by the handicap of the player with the lowest handicap, who then plays from scratch. Each of the other players is allowed 100% of the difference.

Brackets will be posted Friday, September 10th. All round one matches to be played by tee times on Saturday, September 11th. Your second and third round matches will be scheduled by the competitors with approximately two weeks between matches. A consolation bracket will be formed by the losers of the round one matches on September 11th.

The entry fee is \$100 per team. All entrants will be guaranteed two matches. The competition should be completed by late October.
