CART RULES: In case you haven't noticed, it is HOT! Please observe these cart rules without exception due to the warm drought conditions. Use 90 degree from the tee box to your ball and then drive in the fairways. Avoid driving in the rough. Stay on cart paths on all Par 3's and at the tees and greens. Double up on carts to save further cart damage to the golf course.

GOLF DRESS CODE: Please respect our proper golf attire. Collared shirts required. Some non-collared tech shirts are acceptable provided they are not graphic and in good condition. Traditional ladies sleeveless golf blouses are acceptable. No Tank Tops! Traditional golf shorts or pants and hemmed denim in good condition are acceptable. No gym shorts. Flat soled tennis shoes or spikeless golf shoes. No steel spikes or athletic cleated shoes allowed.


carts will be provided both days. registration is required at the Golf Shop. There is no entry fee for this teen championship. There will be a small charge for food and drink following play.
